Papa Francisco nomeia 21 novos cardeais, aumentando significativamente o tamanho do colégio de cardeais e estendendo onabet dicas marca no grupo de prelados que um dia elegerão seu sucessor

Eles incluem um homem que será o cardeal mais velho – Monsenhor Angelo Acerbi, um diplomata vaticano aposentado de 99 anos que foi mantido onabet dicas cativeiro por seis semanas na Colômbia por guerrilheiros de esquerda – e o mais jovem: Bispo Mykola Bychok, o chefe de 44 anos da Igreja Grega Católica Ucraniana onabet dicas Melbourne, Austrália, que foi nomeado onabet dicas homenagem à guerra na Ucrânia.

Os novos cardeais receberão seus chapéus vermelhos onabet dicas uma cerimônia, conhecida como consistório, onabet dicas 8 de dezembro, um dia santo que oficialmente começa a temporada de Natal onabet dicas Roma. Será o décimo consistório do papa para nomear novos príncipes da igreja e o mais grandioso ingresso de cardeais votantes na faculdade onabet dicas seu pontificado de 11 anos. Acerbi é o único dos novos ingressos que está acima dos 80 anos e, portanto, muito velho para votar onabet dicas um novo papa.

Entre os nomeados por Francisco, que onabet dicas 2013 se tornou o primeiro papa latinoamericano, estão os chefes de várias dioceses e arquidioceses importantes da América do Sul. Eles são Vicente Bokalic Iglic, o arcebispo de Santiago del Estero na Argentina; Jaime Spengler, o arcebispo de Porto Alegre no Brasil; Fernando Natalio Chomalí Garib, o arcebispo de Santiago, no Chile; Luis Gerardo Cabrera Herrera, o arcebispo de Guayaquil no Equador; e Carlos Gustavo Castillo Mattasoglio, o arcebispo de Lima, no Peru.

Em contraste, apenas um novo cardeal da América do Norte foi nomeado: o arcebispo de Toronto, Francis Leo.

Francisco nomeou Dominique Joseph Mathieu, o arcebispo de Teerã, no Irã; e Paskalis Bruno Syukur, o bispo de Bogor, na Indonésia. Eles pertencem à Ordem Franciscana e são dois dos quatro novos cardeais franciscanos.

Além de Syukur, a Ásia terá mais dois cardeais onabet dicas Tarcisio Isao Kikuchi, o arcebispo de Tóquio; e Pablo Virgilio Siongco David, o bispo de Caloocan nas Filipinas.

A África terá dois novos cardeais: Ignace Bessi Dogbo, o arcebispo de Abidjan na Costa do Marfim, e Jean-Paul Vesco, o arcebispo de Argel.

"Francisco continuou a estender o alcance do colégio de cardeais", disse o prof Christopher Bellitto, historiador da igreja na Universidade Kean onabet dicas Union, New Jersey. "Como seus predecessores, mas ainda mais, ele está garantindo que os líderes católicos da igreja nas margens tenham uma voz na mesa grande."

Antes do anúncio de domingo, Francisco havia nomeado a maioria dos cardeais votantes abaixo dos 80 anos que votarão onabet dicas um conclave no futuro. Bellitto disse que era "nonsense" ler o nomeamento dos novos cardeais como Francisco tentando empilhar o baralho. "Todo superintendente escolar, presidente e primeiro-ministro escolhe pessoas onabet dicas imagem para ajudar onabet dicas visão", disse ele onabet dicas um email.

A nomeação de Bychok dá à Ucrânia seu único cardeal, enviando uma mensagem político-subtil à medida que a guerra da Rússia continua.
